

Most of the electronic journals and databases available to the SNU are the result of negotiated licenses and agreements between publishers and the SNU Library. Members of the SNU community should make good faith efforts to comply with the licensed terms of these products. Failure to do so can result in individuals' IP addresses being blocked by the publishers from further downloading and result in permanent suspension of the University's access to a particular resource.



It is generally acceptable to

- ✓ Download, copy and print individual articles and search results.
- ✓ Use for the purposes of research, teaching and private study.
- ✓ Post the URL to the publisher's version of the article on a class website. (Publisher links will allow only authorized users access.)

Publishers monitor web sites to make sure their materials are not being abused.



It is not acceptable to

- ✓ Systematically download large amounts of material . (e.g. entire books or journal issues)
- ✓ Facilitate unauthorized access of non-SNU users by forwarding materials or sharing passwords.
- Use for commercial purposes, re-publish, redistribute or alter content.
- ✓ Modify or create a derivative work of the licensed materials
 without the permission of the licensor.
- ✓ Download excessive number of articles from a single IP.
